Travel Itinerary

Day 1: Hue - Arrival (-/-/D)

Welcome to Hue, the former capital of the Nguyen Dynasty and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Upon arrival, your guide and driver will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel for check-in.

The remainder of the day is free at your leisure.

In the evening, meet your guide for a trip briefing and dinner at one of Hue's many fine restaurants.

Overnight in Hue

Distance and travel time:

Transfer: 30 minutes

Day 2: Hue - Lang Co (B/L/-)

The morning's cycling begins with a ride along the coast from Hue to the fishing village of Lang Co. The road is lined with sand dunes and palm trees, with occasional mausoleums, pagodas, and war memorials along the way. Stop for lunch at a local café, then continue along quiet back roads through fishing villages and the Cau Hai lagoon to Lang Co Beach.

Overnight in Lang Co

Distance and travel time:

Cycling distance: up to 65 km

Difficulty: Medium

Day 3: Lang Co - Hoi An (B/L/-)

Today features one of the most challenging rides of the trip: the legendary Hai Van Pass, Vietnam's highest mountain road. Begin with a short, flat warm-up ride from the hotel to the base of the pass, followed by a 10-kilometer ascent gaining 550 meters in elevation. The coastal views from the summit are spectacular — a well-earned reward.

Cruise downhill for 9 kilometers to Danang City for lunch. Continue toward Marble Mountain and My Khe Beach for a refreshing swim. Arrive in Hoi An late afternoon and unwind with a stroll through its quiet, historic streets.

Overnight in Hoi An

Distance and travel time:

Cycling distance: up to 55 km

Difficulty: Medium

Day 4: Hoi An - My Son - Hoi An (B/L/-)

Today's ride takes you to My Son, the ancient heart of the Cham civilization. Begin with a short transfer out of town to avoid the highway, then cycle along scenic country roads, rice paddies, eucalyptus forests, and picturesque villages. The winding roads lead to My Son — once Champa's greatest city, now an impressive archaeological site.

Enjoy lunch near the sanctuary, then spend the afternoon exploring the crumbling temples before returning to Hoi An by bus.

Overnight in Hoi An

Distance and travel time:

Transfer: 1 hour

Cycling distance: up to 54 km

Difficulty: Medium

Day 5: Hoi An - My Lai - Quang Ngai (B/L/-)

Start the morning with a transfer from Hoi An toward Quang Ngai to begin the day's ride. The route is shaded by arching palm trees and bordered by rice paddies, leading to My Lai — site of one of the worst massacres of the Vietnam War. After lunch, take a sobering guided tour of the site and museum, then continue cycling through the Vietnamese countryside to visit a traditional pagoda. Ride on to Quang Ngai for relaxation and a delicious dinner.

Overnight in Quang Ngai

Distance and travel time:

Transfer: 2 hours

Cycling distance: up to 50 km

Difficulty: Medium

Day 6: Quang Ngai - Quy Nhon (B/L/-)

Depart early for the 110-kilometer ride to Quy Nhon — an American port and supply hub during the Vietnam War, which sheltered thousands fleeing the bombing of the countryside. Ride southeast along the coast beyond Thi Nai Bridge, pedaling along tranquil, rarely visited roads. Arrive at your hotel in Quy Nhon in the afternoon and enjoy downtime on the beach to rest tired muscles.

Overnight in Quy Nhon

Distance and travel time:

Transfer: 1 hour

Cycling distance: up to 60 km

Difficulty: Medium

Day 7: Quy Nhon - Tuy Hoa (B/L/-)

After a short shuttle out of town (to avoid the main highway), begin today's ride at Dieu Tri. Cycle along a remote, well-paved road running parallel to the railway through rolling terrain. Pass through Vietnamese and ethnic minority villages for a glimpse of traditional rural life as you head south. Loop back toward the main highway, with the option to cycle or transfer by vehicle for the final hour to Tuy Hoa.

Overnight in Tuy Hoa

Distance and travel time:

Transfer: 1 hour

Cycling distance: up to 70 km

Difficulty: Medium

Day 8: Tuy Hoa - Whale Island (B/L/-)

Today is your final cycling day — and perhaps the most memorable. Depart the hotel for a 20-kilometer ride past lush rice fields blanketing the valley. Climb 3.4 kilometers over a pass, then descend to stunning Dai Lanh Beach for a swim and snacks.

Continue along the coast for 3 kilometers, then turn onto the Hon Gom peninsula road for the final 20 kilometers. Walk a short distance through a local fishing village to your waiting speedboat, which will take you to Whale Island for two nights of relaxation.

Overnight on Whale Island

Distance and travel time:
Transfer: 45 minutes
Cycling distance: up to 58 km
Difficulty: Medium

Day 9: Whale Island (B/-/-)

Today is free to explore Whale Island, relax on the beach, or enjoy snorkeling and scuba diving.

In the evening, savor a delicious seafood farewell dinner.

Overnight on Whale Island

Day 10: Whale Island - Nha Trang - Departure (B/-/-)

Transfer back to the mainland this morning and proceed to the airport or train station for your departure or connecting transport. Alternatively, book additional nights on Whale Island or in Nha Trang to extend your beach stay.

Transfer: 1 hour
